Not achieved in previous period:	Issues for resolution:
 Laydown Area East - Completion of construction as per the contractual completion date was not achieved. This is not currently expected to delay the Laydown Area West contractor, however it may require some re-sequencing of operations if the completion of Laydown Area East is not done before Laydown Area West start. Senior level meetings between the NLHPP team and the Contractor have been held to expedite the remaining work. Collaboration Tool - Roll out of programme collaboration tool Asite – trainings have been delivered and majority of data has been migrated, however configuration has taken longer than anticipated. No adverse consequences are anticipated due to this delay. 	 Laydown Area East - contractor (Buckingham) currently behind contract completion date - no impact on other works foreseen, but discussions ongoing. Task order process - development to align with revised working practices and quality controls/project controls for LEL and advisor submissions. Northern Area Clearance - work requiring focussed attention to define scope of works and ensure management action - change being raised to create new project and incorporate LEL scope.
