- Delivering essential green infrastructure in north London including waste management and recycling facilities.

- Successful recruitment campaign with over 300 applications for apprenticeships on EcoPark South.
- The first 10 apprentices are working across the NLHPP with contractors Galldris, Buckingham and Taylor Woodrow, the majority of whom are Enfield residents.
- One of the apprentices is working with a NLHPP partner company on EcoPark South.
- More apprentices will start later this year.


