- Successful recruitment campaign with over **300 applications** for apprenticeships on EcoPark South.
- The first **10 apprentices** are working across the NLHPP with contractors Galldris, Buckingham and Taylor Woodrow, the majority of whom are **Enfield residents**.
- One of the apprentices is working with a NLHPP partner company on EcoPark South.
- More apprentices will start later this year.

# On-site trainees update

- So far **23** on-site training placements have been delivered.
- NLHPP has committed to delivering 225 training placements throughout the construction period



- Temporary pause in construction works in March due to COVID-19.
- **Full remobilisation in June** with new health and safety measures implemented, complying with guidance set by the **Construction Leadership Council** and **Public Health England**

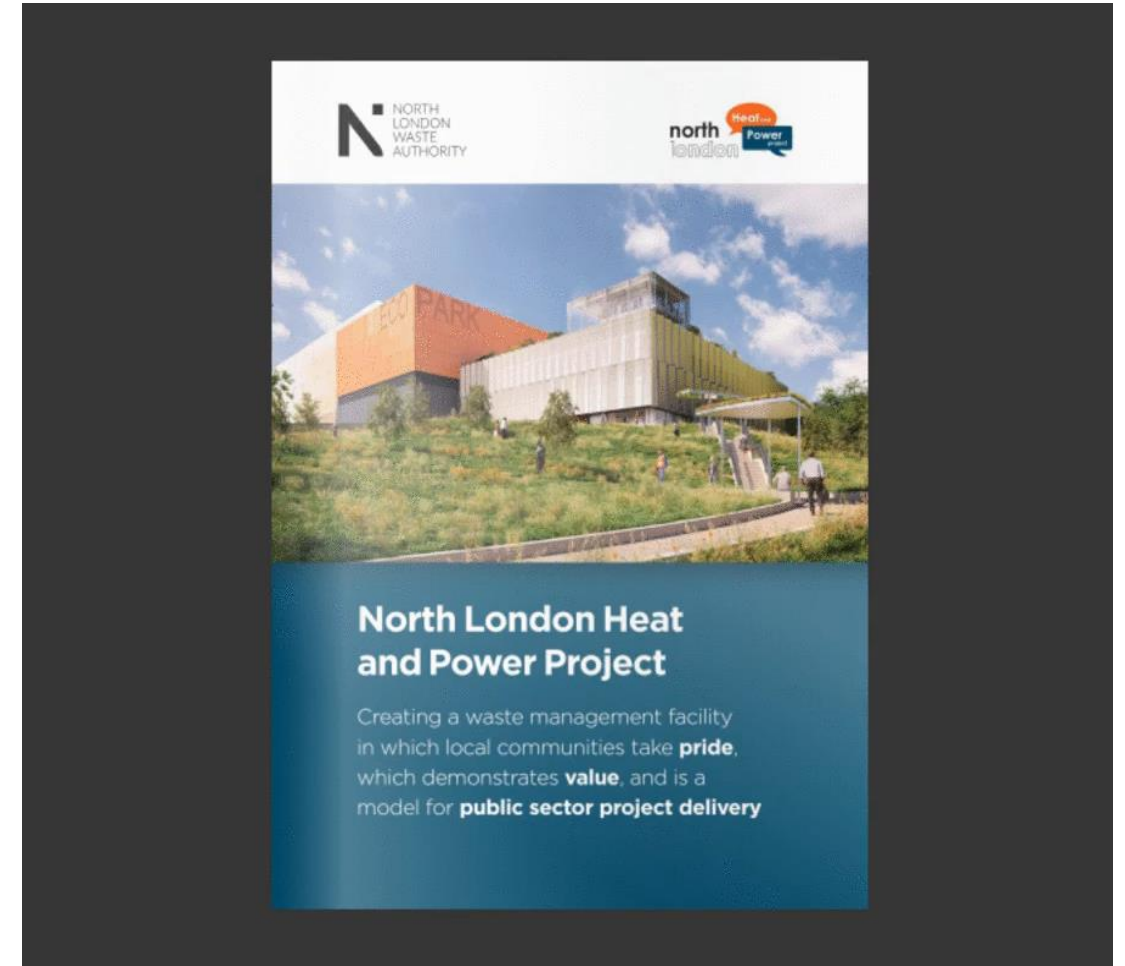


