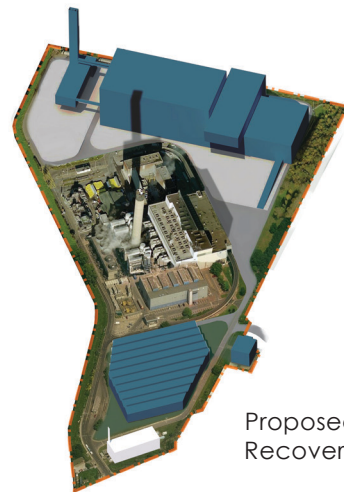

## What's this all about?

The North London Heat and Power Project is our proposal to build an Energy Recovery Facility to replace the existing plant at the EcoPark in Edmonton by 2025, so we can continue to recover energy – heat and power – from the waste left over after recycling.

## Why a replacement facility?

### Current facility:

- Has served north London for 45 years
- Likely to reach end of its useful life in around 10 years
- Has diverted 21 million tonnes of waste from landfill

### Landfill isn't a long-term option because:

- Taxation makes it expensive
- Sites are almost all outside London
- Produces methane – a potent greenhouse gas

### New facility would:

- Provide enough power for 127,000 homes
- Be a replacement facility
- Be modern and efficient
- Be designed to respond sympathetically to Lee Valley Regional Park
- Have even better emission control than it does now

North London Waste Authority (NLWA) arranges the disposal of waste collected by the seven London boroughs of Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Hackney, Haringey, Islington and Waltham Forest.
